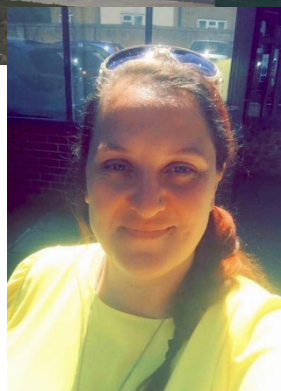

The Zone has two part-time members of staff who are employed by Market Drayton Town Council.

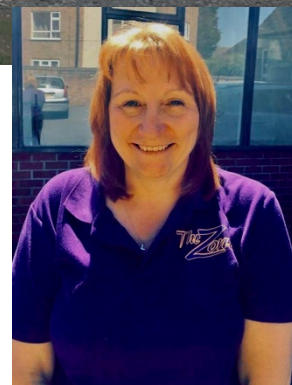
