3.CG CONSULTATIONS

i. Members considered the draft response to the Shropshire Council Budget Consultation as set out in Appendix CG141.

Councillor Nellins said the consultation had been considered by Cllr Glover, Cllr Hughes, and himself, they tried to be realistic in their answers. After a brief discussion.

Councillor Sanderson proposed, Councillor Chapman seconded, and it was **RESOLVED:**

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ii.
