3.PL **PUBLIC SESSION**

Councillor Nellins proposed, Councillor Allen seconded and it was RESOLVED:

To suspend standing Orders to allow a member of the public to speak.

A member of the public requested that Shropshire Councillors and Town Councillors consider the following issues:

Planning permission. Why does Shropshire Council keep pushing planning applications through for extra houses when there is not sufficient infrastructure in the town eg electricity supply, schools and doctors at capacity. developments? The town needs more social housing for the underpaid workforce.

Initial:

- Transport. There is talk that the bus to Stoke is reducing its service within
 the week and not running at all on a Saturday, can Town Council get
 behind this to stop it happening, the town is already isolated with no
 transport to Telford; teenagers need to be able to travel out of town to go to
 the pictures etc.
- Policing. Whitchurch has two members of the police patrolling on foot within the town, why can't Market Drayton have this service?
- Severn Trent. Utilities cannot keep up with the amount of sewage and it is overflowing into our waterways. The County Councillors were asked to speak up at County's Planning Meetings to get more involved to try and stop this happening.

The Chairman said he has recently been on a planning course; Town Council are unable to object to new housing developments on the grounds of impact capacity this will have on the doctors and schools, Shropshire Council must have an infrastructure plan.

Councillor Allen said he believes the local school are under subscribed and are not running at capacity. It is about parental choice and a lot of parents are opting to send their child to a different senior school and paying for the transport themselves.

Councillor Nellins said the X64 timetable for the bus service to Hanley was to reduce due to the lack of footfall but Shropshire Council has stepped in to help fund the service so this will continue be the same.

The Chairman thanked the resident for attending the meeting and for her comments.

The meeting went back into committee.
