

Market Drayton Town Council Small Grants for Local Organisations

2020 - 2021

Market Drayton Town Council have allocated £4000 within the budget to help local organisations achieve their aims and objectives.

The Council have a policy of assisting local community groups and applications must be from a properly formed group, club, committee or charity, which must show that the group has community aims whilst benefitting the residents of Market Drayton.

Applicants must write into the Clerk requesting a small grant of up to £300 outlining why they want the funding and how they plan on spending the money.

All applications will be considered at a Finance and General Purposes Committee meeting within the financial year (May and September). Please note only one application from the same organisation will be considered per year.
