i. <u>Croft Way</u>

The installation of the new equipment should be completed.

To consider organising a formal opening of the upgraded play area.

ii. <u>Dalelands</u>

Phase One

The mound has been levelled and work in ongoing to re-turf the area, as resolved at the meeting held on the 29thSeptember 2022, and install new fencing and gates.

Phase Two

The next stage is to produce the specification for the new play equipment and to go out to tender for the work; the results of the residents survey will be used to produce the tender specification.

iii. <u>Westlands</u>

The new climbing frame has been installed.

iv. <u>Rospa</u>

The Annual Rospa inspection report has been received. Remedial works are being carried out and quotes obtained for repairs where necessary.

v. <u>Repairs</u>

The following repairs/equipment have been ordered.

Westlands Play Area	Repairs to wet pour surfacing due to vandalism	£665.00
Cherry Way Play Area	Replacement roundabout due to vandalism	£3,078.00
Abbots Gate Play Area	Repairs to seesaw mechanism due to wear and tear and a replacement seat due to vandalism	£1,590.00

A new swing wheel is required for Longlands play area at a cost of approximately £1,290; an inspection of the swing frame is required prior to ordering; this will take place early October.

vi. New Fencing

Quotes have been obtained to installed new bow top fencing and gates on Cherry Way and Westlands Play Areas.

To consider installing the new fencing and gates as per quotes received.

Funding to be taken from budget and earmarked reserves:

- Grotto Road, £9,963.53 from within Budget
- Westlands Play Area £15,339.20 from Earmarked Reserves

If both quotes are excepted there will be a reduction of \pounds 1,075 of the total cost.
