There continues to be use of drugs in the town; most or which is recreational.

There has been an increase in local intelligence since the new constable has started.

There is a shortage of CSO's; one is off on long term sick and there is a shortage of new recruits. There are police officers based at the Police Station and officer meet in town for morning briefings.

The town continued to be supported by officers/CSO's from surrounding towns. New CSO's should be in place during the summer.

The demand on the police is increasing; the local officers need to move around quicker and do not always have time to walk the beat.
